

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

5760' TD - 5730' DOD - Lime - Drilled out plugs as follows: Baker Bridging Plug @2280'; 2619' to 2670'; 3669' to 3800'. Ran a total of 185 Jts of 7" OD Casing set at 5758' W/650 sacks of cement. Pumped plug to 5698' at 2:00 AM, 11/22/53 - Max pressure 1500#. Ran temperature survey - top of cement outside 7" OD Casing @ 2296', or, 65.3% fill. After WOC for 24 hours drilled out cement from 5697' to 5730' - tested 7" OD Casing W/1500# before and after drilling cement - OK. Circulated hole clean to 5730' and continued with completions operations.
