## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

5760' - Total Depth - Line 9-5/8" csg. set @ 2291'. Spotted cement plug from to 3669' with 50 sacks regular cement. Pulled up hole and Spotted cement plug from 2670' to 2619' with 20 sacks regular cement. Filled hole between plugs with heavy mud. Set Baker Bridging Plug at 2280' and spotted 5 sacks cement on top. Top of cement at 2270'. Finished filling hole with heavy mud and installed 3" 3000# test valve on top of well. Well plugged and temporarily abandoned February 22, 1952.
