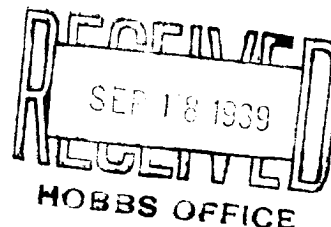
Additional information:
