NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TEST WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in triplicate.

Additional information:

12 1/2" Casing was run to a depth of 196' and 70 sacks of cement was pumped in and plug placed and pumped down with water. When plug was down to a depth of 65 feet the casing parted, just above plug. Cement was bailed out to within four feet of bottom. Casing was joined together and tightened up with steel die nipple a 1" pipe was run down outside of 12 1/2" casing and cement was pumped in until it filled all space around casing to top of well. One hour later bailer was run to bottom and there was no water in casing.
