

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

3910' T.D., 3790' DOD - 8-5/8" OD Csg set @ 2390' & 6-5/8" OD Csg set @ 3790'. Well originally completed July 1, 1936. In November 1953 Plugged back to 3790' to shut off water. 6-5/8" OD Csg perf from 3776' to 3790' & acidized W/500 gal acid. Continued to produce oil from the Monument Pool. Oil is being produced from Monument Pool and is currently carried @ 40 bbls per day on the State Proration Schedule. It is our intention to dual complete this well by perforating the 6-5/8" OD Csg from 3070' to 3200'; 3215 to 3325' & 3355' to 3415' and produce gas thru the csg from the Seven Rivers-Queen Sections. We will continue to produce oil from the Monument Pool.
