DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

8-5/8" 28# 8-thd. New Electric welded casing was set in this well at 2390' and cemented by the Halliburton Method with 500 sacks of cement.

Casing and fittings were tested with 1200# pressure and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. No drop in pressure resulted so the cement plug was then drilled out of casing and the same test of 1200# again applied and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. No drop in pressure resulted so the drilling was then resumed.
