7213' PBD. Lime. Shot well with 128 qts. Safety Oil Well Explosives, from 7155' to 7206' w/5' Pea Gravel & 40' Calseal on top of load. Went in hole w/2-7/8" Drill pipe & 4-3/4" bit & washed out from 6990' to 7209' w/Reverse Circulation. Ran 233 jts. 2-3/8" OD. EUE, 4.7#, J-55, R-2, 8RT. SS Tbg., 1-2 1/2" x 5 1/2" Lane-Wells Formation Packer, 1-2' Handling Sub on Top. Tbg. set at 7209' Packer set at 7112' w/6000# Tested packer w/700# was OK. Tbg. Perf. 7174' to 7177' & 3 jts. 2-7/8" OD, EUE, 6-5#, J-55, R-2, SS. Tbg. (St) Rigged up & started swabbing. First 15 1/2 hrs. swabbed 59.95 Bbls. Fluid, next 24 hrs. swabbed 69.95 bbls. fluid. Results unsatisfactory
