Acid on Formation & Electrode @ 5:00 P.M. T/P/ was 2500# to 3300#, C.P. Was 3000# to 3500# while pumping acid. 37 bbl. oil Flush complete @ 6:20 P.M. T.P. 3300# C.P. 3300# Lowered Tbg. to 7193' & Set Guiberson KV-30 Packer @ 7095'. Tested Packer W/400# was O.K. Rigged up & started swabbing @ 8:30 P.M. Swabbed total of 27 bbls. till 10:00 P.M. & kicked off. and turned to tanks @ 4:00 A.M.
