Acid on formation @ 12:25 A.M. Pressured up on Csg. W/3000# & 3000# on Tbg. Held Pressure from 3000# to 1850# on Tbg. to 1:20 A.M. and @ 1:32 A.M. Formation pressure was 800#. Resumed pumping @ rate of 1 bbl. per min. W/2800# T.P. & 2800# held on Csg. at end of 28 bbl. Flush. Treatment complete @ 1:46 A.M. Rig up & Started swabbing @ 2:45 A.M. Swabbed till 6:00 A.M. & well kicked off, and turned to Tanks.
