7205' Total Depth Lime. Nippled up on 5½" Casing. Layed down 4½" Kelly, Picked up 3½" Kelly, 1-4" Drill collar & 144 joints of 2" EUE Tbg. Went in hole and found top cement @ 4385' Tested casing with 1220# for 30 mins. was OK. Drilled cement from 4385' to 4430'. circulated cement out. Finished Ø plug @ 11:30 A.M. 2-2-49. pressured up on 5½" Csg. with 1300# to test perforations @ 4430'. Pumped 29 bbls. mud in formation w/1500#. Pulled 2" EUE Tbg. & Removed Bit & Drill Collar.
