

Acidized well with 3,000 gals. Dowell 15% acid 3848-3810 on 5-2-49. Well swabbed 132 bbls. water in 8 hrs. No oil. Plugged back well with 2 2/3 sacks cement to 3855. Ran tubing and swabbed 237 bbls. water in 10 hours, 5-12-49. No oil or gas. Plugged back to 3843 with 1 sack cement. Swabbed 242 bbls water and 15 bbls oil in 16 hours, 5-18-49. Pulled tubing and drilled out cement plug 3843-3872. Plugged back to 3832' with 350# hydramite. Swabbed 118 bbls water and 31 bbls oil in 16 hours, 5-24-49. Dumped 7 gals hydramite in hole. Filled up to 3824. On 5-30-49 swabbed 36 bbls water and 13 bbls oil in 5 hours. Drilled out cement plug to 3865. Dumped 2 sacks cement in hole to 3856'. Swabbed 11 bbls oil and 37 bbls water in 16 hours. Plugged back to 3853' with 115# lead wool and 20# putty. Ran tubing to 1' off bottom. Acidized with 500 gals chemical process 15% acid on 6-15-49. Swabbed 48 bbls water with small show oil in 3 hours. Ran spinner survey. Ran 2" tubing with 8 wells flow valves. Plugged well off 6-27-49. On 6-30-49 well flowed by gas lift 66 bbls oil and 350 bbls water in 24 hours. Used 584,000 cu. ft. of gas.
