DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Cement plug was drilled out of pipe and hole was bailed to bottom which showed about 1/3 bailer of water every thirty minutes. Halliburton plug had been pumped to 228'. Well was recemented with 20 sacks of cement with top of Halliburton plug at 207'. Cement was allowed to set 48 hours. Cement plug was again drilled out of pipe and hole was bailed to bottom and allowed to stand undisturbed for 1 hour. Bailer was again run to bottom which showed that no water had accumulated.
