Gentlemen:

By this letter of application Amerada Petroleum Corporation wishes to state the following:

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13 MAR 1956
- (A) That Amerada Petroleum Corporation's State "J" No. 3 is located 1980 ft. FSL and 1980 ft. FWL of Section 2, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico. The well is located on a 120 acre lease being the E₁/₂ of the SE₁/₄ and the NE₁/₄ of the SW₁/₄ of Section 2, Township 20 South, Range 36 East. The well was completed April 1936, at a total depth of 3930 ft. The attached Exhibit A shows the location of this well together with the location of all offset wells.
- (B) That the subject well has 6-5/8" casing set at 3810 ft. and cemented with 100 sacks of cement. The well is an oil well producing from the open hole interval from 3810 ft. to 3930 ft. in the Grayburg formation, Monument Pool.
- (C) That the applicant proposes to dually complete this well in the following manner:
- (1) Perforate the 6-5/8" casing in the approximate interval of 3400 ft. to 3500 ft. in the Queen formation, Eumont Gas Pool.
 - (2) Set production type packer at approximately 3700 ft. to separate the two zones.
 - (3) Produce the Grayburg oil through the tubing and the Queen gas through the tubing-casing annulus. The attached Exhibit "B" is a diagrammatic sketch of the proposed dual completion.

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
