DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

8-5/8" 28# New Casing was set in this well at 2346' and cemented by the Halliburton Method with 500 sacks of cement.

Casing and fittings were tested with 1200# pressure and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. Cement plug was drilled out of casing, and casing again tested by the same test and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. No drop in pressure resulted. Drilling was resumed.
