THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

Article I

Section 1

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2

1. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors in that State.

2. No Person shall be a Representative who shall not have attained to the Age of twenty five Years, seven Years a Citizen of the United States, and when elected shall have been seven Years a Citizen of that State in which he shall be chosen.

3. Representatives and direct Taxes shall be apportioned among the several States which may be included within this Union, according to their respective Numbers, which shall be determined by adding to the whole Number of free Persons, including all bound Persons, except Indians not taxed, three fifths of all other Persons.

4. The House of Representatives shall choose their Speaker and other Officers; and shall have the sole Power of Impeachment.

Section 3

1. The Senate of the United States shall be composed of two Senators from each State, chosen by the Legislature thereof, for six Years; and each Senator shall have the Qualifications requisite for Senators in that State.

2. No Person shall be a Senator who shall not have attained to the Age of thirty Years, seven Years a Citizen of the United States, and when elected shall have been seven Years a Citizen of that State in which he shall be chosen.

3. The Senate shall have the sole and exclusive Power of trying all Impeachments.

Section 4

1. The Senators and Representatives before Congress, and the Members of the several State Legislatures, and all Persons holding Office under any of them, shall be sworn or affirmed to support this Constitution.

2. The Congress shall assemble at least once in every Year, and such Meeting shall be held on the first Monday in December, unless they shall by Law appoint a different Day.

Section 5

1. The Congress shall have Power to regulate the Time, Place and Manner of holding Elections for Senators and Representatives, but no Senator or Representative, or Elector in any State, shall be seated in either House until he shall have taken the Oath or Affirmation.

2. The Congress may determine the Rules and Proceedings of the Senate, and the Rules and Proceedings of the House of Representatives, but the Senate and House of Representatives may, by their respective Journals, determine the Rules and Proceedings of their own Bodies.

Section 6

1. The Senators and Representatives, and Members of the several State Legislatures, and all Persons holding Office under any of them, shall be privileged from Arrest during their Attendance at the Session of their respective Bodies, except in Cases of Treason, Felony, or Breach of the Peace.

2. The Congress shall have Power to expel a Member for any Breach of the Rules or Proceedings of the House or Senate.

Section 7

1. All Bills for raising Revenue shall originate in the House of Representatives; but the Senate may propose or concur with Amendments as to the Form of such Bills.

2. No Bill shall be passed by Congress until it has passed three Readings in each House, and the Yeas and Nays of the Members of each House shall be entered on the Journal.

Section 8

1. The Congress shall have Power to lay and collect Taxes, Duties, Imposts and Excises, to pay the Debts and provide for the common Defence and general Welfare of the United States; but all Taxes on Imports and Exports shall be uniform throughout the United States.

2. The Congress shall have Power to borrow Money on the Credit of the United States, to regulate Commerce with foreign Nations, to regulate Commerce among the several States, and to regulate Commerce with the Indian Tribes.

3. The Congress shall have Power to coin Money, to regulate the Value of Money, to fix the Standard of Weights and Measures, to provide for the Punishment of counterfeiting the Securities and current Coin of the United States.

4. The Congress shall have Power to establish an uniform Rule of Naturalization, to establish an uniform Bankruptcy Law, to regulate the Bankruptcy of the United States, to regulate the Bankruptcy of the several States, to regulate the Bankruptcy of the Indian Tribes.
