### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On March 2, 1940, a 2 1/2" EUE x 5 1/2" Actual OD x 32" Exner-Dodge Underset Formation Packer was set at 3882' with 10 feet immediately above packer perforated.

Production before: Would not flow. Could swab only water.

Production after: Flowed 115 bbls oil and 12 bbls water in 24 hours, flowing thru 1/2" choke 1 1/2 rounds open with 507,000 cu. ft. gas.
