Killed well. Pulled tubing and packer and re-run tubing with a Model MG100 Sweet Packer set at 3823.75' to shut off upper gas and swabbed well dry. Acidized with 1,000 galoons acid. Well was tested on 10-6-54 by S.J. Stanley, Engineer for the Oil Conservation Commission. Well made 41 barrels oil in 24 hours. GOR 863 to 1.
