DETAILS OF WORK

It is our intention to drill a well at the above location to a total depth of approximately 4,350' with rotary tools in an attempt to obtain commercial production in the Queen. All casing points will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the U. S. Geological Survey and any other special requirements will be complied with.

It is planned to use the following casing patterns: 8 1/8" casing to be set at 325' and cemented with approximately 250 sacks cement, cement to circulate to surface; 5 1/2" casing to be set at approximately 4,350' and cemented with approximately 975 sacks cement or as determined by survey. Selectively perforate and test opposite the pay zone.

Approval to produce this well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

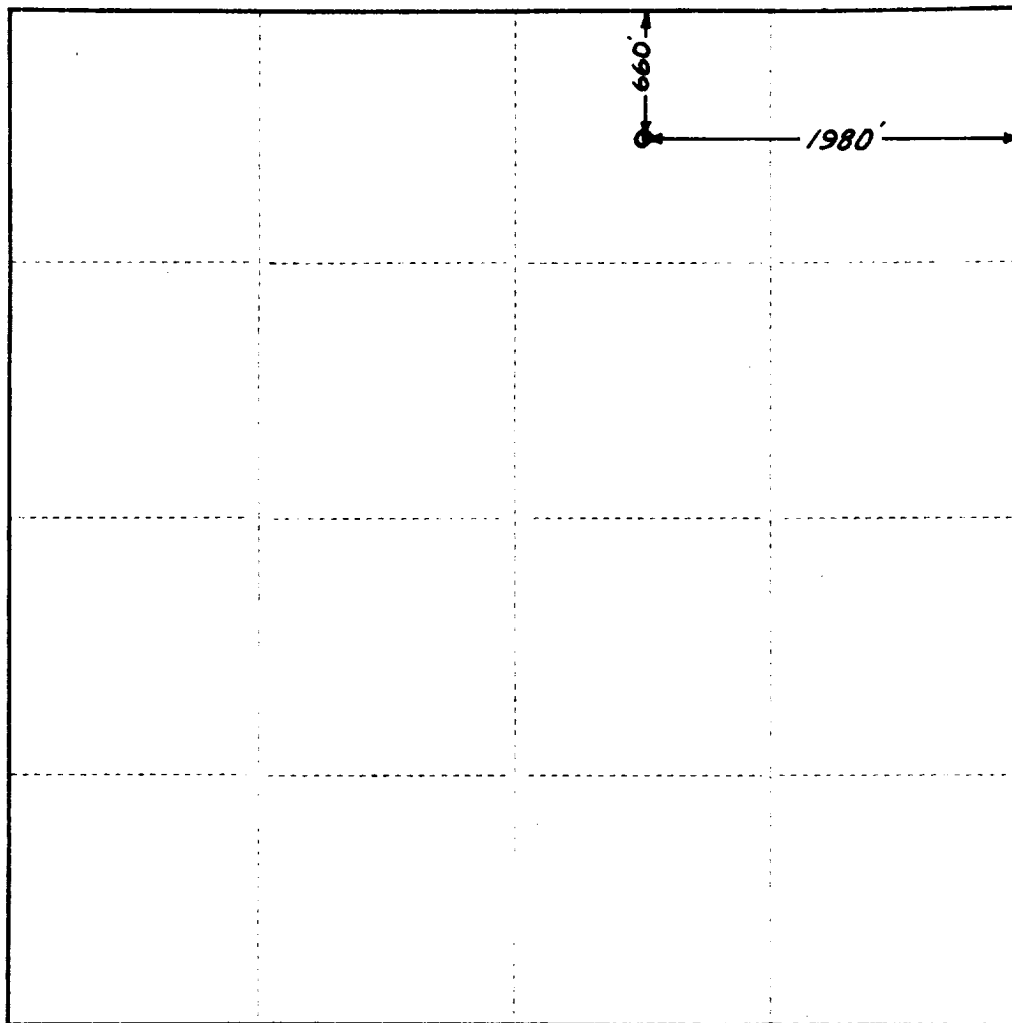
