Set 5 1/2" casing at 4017', cemented with 1,000 sacks Inferno 85 Gal., 125 sacks Stratacrete, 100 sacks Incor Sulphate cement, using 13 centralizers and 130 scratchers. Plug down at 5:00 A.M. 12-21-55. Temperature survey showed top of cement at 455'.

Tested casing with 1,000# pressure before drilling plug. No pressure drop. Drilled out cement plug to 4017'. Tested casing with 1,000# pressure. No pressure drop.
