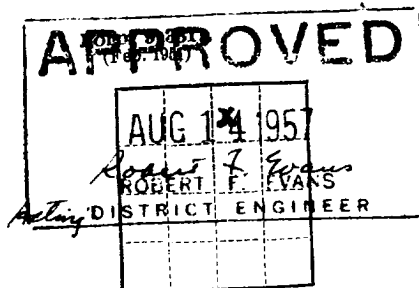

It is our intention to drill a well at the above location to a total to a total depth of approximately 4000' with rotary tools in an attempt to obtain commercial production in the near. All casing points will be cemented in accordance with approved methods of the U. S. Geological Survey and any other special requirements will be complied with.

It is planned to use the following casing pattern. 8 5/8" to be set 3 300' and cemented with 250 sacks cement, cement to be circulated. 5 1/2" casing to be set 3 4000' with 1700 sacks cement.

Approval to produce this well upon completion is also requested.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
