Gentlemen:

Sinclair Oil & Gas Company makes this application for an Administrative Order under Order R-520 which will establish a 320 acre Nonstandard Gas Proration Unit in the Eumont Gas Pool to be assigned to Sinclair's Wm. P. Byrd Well No. 7.

In this connection Sinclair wishes to state:

- 1. Sinclair is the operator of the Nm. P. Byrd Well No. 7 which is located in the NE NW of Section ll-20S-36E, Lea County, New Mexico. This well was completed March 4, 1954 as a gas well in the Eumont Gas Pool with an open flow capacity of 8,100 MCF per day.
- 2. The proposed Nonstandard Unit consists of Sinclair's Wm. P. Byrd and Mary J. Byrd leases and occupies the NN/4, N/2 of SW/4 and W/2 of NE/4 of said Section 11. Sinclair's Wm. P. Byrd No. 7 Well is located 990 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the Vest line of this proposed unit thus qualifying for a 320 acre administrative assignment.
- 3. The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 5280 feet.
- 4. The proposed unit consists of contiguous quarterquarter sections and lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- 5. The entire proposed unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
