DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

3901' Total Depth, Plugged back from 3901' to 3971' in 9 stages, total of 200 Gallons of Dowell Plastic, did not hold, and drilled out to 3894' and plugged back from 3894' to 3868' in 2 stages with 36 gallons of Dowell Plastic, and set 3" EUE Tubing at 3858' and swabbed 39 hours and swabbed 318.03 barrels oil and 120.13 barrel of water, did not have shut off, of water. Plugged back from 3868' to 3846' with 32 gallons of Halliburton Hydromite, set 3" EUE Tubing at 3839' and swabbed 196.79 barrels oil and 48.85 barrels water in 16 hours, well would not flow and pulled 3" EUE Tubing and ran packer to test casing and casing did not have leak.
