### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The above described well was treated with 2000 Gallons of Lowell EX Acid on August 27, 1935. As a result of the treatment the production was increased from 30 barrels of oil and very small amount of gas per day to 313 Bbls oil in 3½ Hrs with gas at rate of 7,250 ft per day. Notice of intention to do this work was not sent in as it was part of completion of well.
