This well was drilled to a total depth of 3885'. 2 1/2" upset tubing was set at 3882'. The well was then swabbed and did not produce much oil. The well was then acidized with 2000 gallons of Dowell XX acid. Acid set 6 hours and the well was then swabbed in and flowed 362 barrels of clean oil on 17 hour test. Hourly average of 21.3 bbls. Flowing through 2 1/2" tubing and 1" open choke. Gas volume of 374,000 daily. Gas oil ratio of 732.
