This well was drilled to the total depth of 3875'. 2 1/2" upset tubing was set at 3820'. Well was swabbed in and flowed 110 1/2 barrels pipe line oil on 15 hour test. Flowing through 1" open choke on 2 1/2" tubing. Daily gas rate of 1,500,000. First 7 hours of the 15 hour test was thru 1" open choke and the well made 69 barrels. The last 8 hours of the test was through 2 1/2" Choke and made 21 1/2 barrels. Tubing pressure 1000#. Casing pressure 1200#.
