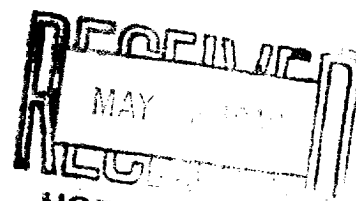

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

3884' Drilled Out Depth. Loaded hole with 150 bbls. oil, pulled and reran tubing with bull plugged joint on bottom and perforated sub above packer set at 3749'. Acidized with 250 gallons Dowell IX-15% Acid and formation broke from 1425# to 800#. Oil flush of 21-3/4 bbls. complete at 7:10PM, 4-26-48. Ran 127 jts. of 2-7/8" OD, EUE, 6.5#, J-55, R-2, 8-RT, SS Tbg. and Quiberson Packer w/1-3' perf. sub on bottom bull plugged, 1-6' & 1-8' sub on top. Bottom of tbg. at 3879' and packer is swinging at 3783'. Swabbed 91.08 bbls. fluid and well started flowing. In 1 hr. to 7:00AM, 4-27-48, flowed 27.60 bbls. fluid on 3/4" choke. Flowed and swabbed 8 hrs. and recovered 173.88 bbls. fluid, 12.15 BSW, gas 203M, GOR 443. Pulled swab 5 times. At 3:30PM, 4-27-48, shut well in and released rig.
