## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

3884' Drilled Out Depth. Acidized with 500 gallons Dowell 15% Low Tension Acid and started acid in tubing at 4:30AM, 4-23-48 with packer open. Shut down to close packer. At 5:55AM, 800' on tubing and oil flush of 22 $\frac{1}{2}$  bbls. complete. Bled pressures off well. Pulled swab 5 times and well started flowing at 7:15AM, 4-23-48. Turned to tanks on 1/2" choke. Tried various chokes. In 24 hrs. to 7:00AM, 4-24-48, well flowed 502.35 bbls. fluid on various chokes. In the last 11 hrs. flowed 362.23 bbls. ~~at~~ fluid on 3/4" choke, 15% water. Gas 310,000 per day based on last 11 hrs. GFR 395 based on last 11 hrs.
