DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

8400' Plugged Back Depth. Shot 5 1/2" OD Casing with 2 quarts Nitroglycerin each shot at 8253', 7950' and 7885'. Could not circulate and could not pull casing. Shot again at 7750' and broke circulation with water with 1400#. Circulated 5 1/2 hrs. to 1:00AM 4-7-48. Spotted 285 bbls. oil in and around casing and circulated through shot at 7750'. Circulated and worked casing but would not come loose. Ran McCullough Magna-tector and found that casing is stuck at 7610'. Ran McCullough Jet Cutter and shot casing first at 7520' and then at 7525'. Pipe came loose, pulled out of hole and corrected last shot from 7525' to 7516.96'. Shot off joint #29 from bottom and recovered 192 jts. of 5 1/2" OD, 17#, J-55, R-3, 8-RT Casing for 7504.96', threads off. Left in hole, 29 jts. for 1132' threads off.
