

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

8603' Drilled Out Depth. Acidized with 2000 gallons Dowell 15% Low Tension Acid. Opened packer, started circulation with water and started acid in tubing at 4:17AM, 4-4-48. At 4:35AM closed packer and pressured up on casing with 1500#. At 5:45AM, tbg. 2500#. At 5:55AM, tbg. 2400#. At 6:05AM, tbg. 2000#. At 6:10AM, tbg. 1300#. At 6:16AM, tbg. 1600# and oil flush of 33 bbls. complete. Bled pressure off well to tanks and started swabbing at 7:00AM. At 6:30AM, 4-5-48, had recovered 329.70 bbls. fluid, straight sulphur water since 6:00PM, 4-4-48. No gas, no oil. Fluid level 700' from top.
