DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

5176' Total Depth, Lime. Ran temperature survey and found top of cement at 2325', 73% of calculated fill. Nipped up 8-5/8" casing, went in hole with drill pipe and 7-3/4" bit and drilled out cement from 5109' to 5176'. Tested casing with 1000# for 30 minutes before and after drilling cement and was OK. Started drilling 7-3/4" hole at 5176' at 3:17AM, 11-9-47.
