DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

12 1/2" 40# 8-Thd. New Lapweld Casing was set in this well at 208' and cemented by the Halliburton Method with 200 Sacks.

Cement was drilled out of the casing and the hole was then bailed dry and allowed to stand undisturbed for one hour. The bailer was then run to bottom to determine if any water had accumulated. No water had accumulated so the drilling was then resumed.
