3860' Plugged back depth, Acidized with 1000 Gallons of Dowell XF-18 Acid with Maximum Tubing pressure 900#, Minimum Tubing Pressure 600#, Pulled Tubing up to 3844' with packer set at 3699' and swabbed well in 2 1/2 hours, and well started flowing and put on 1/2" Choke and in 6 1/2 hours flowed 87.35 bbls Oil, 28.29 bbls water, Tubing pressure 140#, Gas Volume 184M per day Gas-Fluid Ratio 431 and Gas-Oil-Ratio 569. Well Completed.
