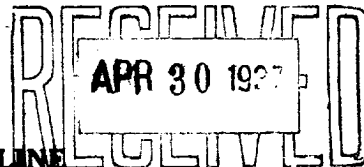

This well was drilled to the total depth of 3680'. 2 1/8" upset tubing was set at 3675'. Well was swabbed in and flowed 812 barrels oil on 8-2/3 hour test. Hourly average of 86-2/3 barrels. Flowing through 1" openchoke on 2 1/8" upset tubing. Daily gas rate of 800,000. Gas oil ratio of 389. Tubing pressure 150#. Casing pressure of 800#.
