This well was drilled to the total depth of 3875'. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " upset tubing was set at 3872'. Swabbed in and flowed 167 barrels oil on 5-1/4 hour test. Through 1" open choke on 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " upset tubing. Gas volume of 250,000'. Gas oil ratio 343. Tubing pressure 15#. casing pressure 250#.

Flowed 313 barrels oil on 10-1/4 hour test. Through 1" open choke. Gas volume of 271,000'. Gas oil ratio 364. Hourly average of 31 barrels. Tubing pressure 20#. Casing pressure 275#.
