Gentlemen:

By copy of this letter Amerada Petroleum Corporation wishes to state
the following:

- (1) That Amerada Petroleum Corporation has formed a 320 acre gas unit consisting of E/2 of the N/2 and the W/2 of the E/2 of Section 12, Township 20-S, Range 36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. This unit has been formed by pooling the 240 acre Amerada Byrd Lease with the 80 acre Amerada Byrd "A" Lease and is to be known as the Amerada "Byrd Gas Unit".
- (2) That Amerada Petroleum Corporation Byrd Gas Unit No. 1 is to be drilled 2315.5' FNL and 2310' FNL of Section 12, Township 20-S, Range 36-E, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (3) That this proposed non-standard proration unit for gas consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections, and does not exceed 5280' in length or width.
- (4) That by copy of this letter of application by registered mail all offset operators are notified.

Therefore, Amerada Petroleum Corporation requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant approval of this non-standard gas proration unit as proposed in this application.
