DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

All perforations were cemented and squeezed off. The hole was filled with 9.8 mud and cement plug was set in the 7" casing from 5112' to 5237'. The 7" casing was cut and pulled at 3135'. A 100 sack plug was placed in the bottom of the 9 5/8" casing. A cement cap was placed in the top of the 9 5/8" casing and 4" pipe marker was placed in well. No recover was attempted on 9 5/8" of 13 3/8" as 13 3/8" was cemented to 9 5/8" to surface.
