Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas production unit comprising the SE/4 of Section 13, T-20-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as its R. R. Bell "Q" Lease located in the S/2 SE/4 of Section 13, T-20-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Amarada Petroleum Corporation is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as its State "H" Lease located in NW/4 SE/4 of Section 13, T-20-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Superior Oil Company is owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as its State "A" Lease located in NE/4 SE/4 of Section 13, T-20-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The Gulf, Amarada and Superior leases comprise the 160 acres above described.
- (2) Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner and operator of the R. R. Bell "Q" Well No. 1 located 660 feet from the East line and 660 feet from the South line of Section 13, T-20-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, which was completed April 28, 1956, as a gas-oil dual well. This well is in the Eusnet Gas Pool and Monument Oil Pool.
- (3) Gulf Oil Corporation, Amarada Petroleum Corporation and Superior Oil Company are in the process of preparing agreements for the communitization of their respective leases in the above described quarter section and for the operation of said quarter section after communitization as a non-standard 160-acre gas production unit. the 32 1/4 of section 13, T-20-S, R-36-E, Lee County,
New Mexico. American Petroleum Corporation is owner and
operator of an oil and gas lease known as the "B" lease
located in NW 1/4 of section 13, T-20-S, R-36-E,
Lee County, New Mexico. Superior Oil Company is owner
and operator of an oil and gas lease known as the "A"
lease located in NW 1/4 of section 13, T-20-S,
R-36-E, Lee County, New Mexico. The "G", "B", and
"A" leases comprise the 100 acres above described.
