DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

A 29' Calseal plug was placed in the bottom of the hole with 5 feet of cement above the Calseal. After the well was swabbed, it flowed by heads making 20 to 30 barrels per day with 75 percent water. A pumping unit was installed and the well produced at the

rate of 105 barrels of oil and 244 barrels of water per day.
