Gentlemen:

Tide Water Associated Oil Company hereby makes application for administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit, comprising the SW/4 of Section 13, T-20-S, R-36-E, and in support thereof states as follows:

1. Tide Water Associated Oil Company is the owner of State Oil and Gas Lease No. B-2333, which covers the E/2 SW/4 of Section 13, T-20-S, R-36-E. Tide Water Associated Oil Company's State "K" Well #1, located in the center of the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 13, T-20-S, R-36-E, is presently being assigned 80 acres for proration purposes.
2. Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner of State Lease No. A-1543, which covers the W/2 SW/4 of this Section.
3. Tide Water Associated Oil Company and Gulf Oil Corporation have agreed to enter into a unit for the purpose of producing their respective shares of Eumont Pool gas underlying the SW/4 of Section 13, T-20-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, pending the approval of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit.
4. The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:
 - (a) The non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
 - (b) The non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
