DETAILS OF WORK

Sanderson A-14 No. 6 is presently producing a penalized allowable due to an excessive gas-oil ratio of 11,150 cubic feet per barrel.

In an attempt to reduce the gas-oil ratio it is proposed to ream out Sanderson A-14 No. 6 to total depth (3670'). A 4" OD liner will be set on bottom and cemented with approximately 50 sacks cement. The liner will be perforated opposite the favorable zones as indicated by a radioactivity survey and the pay added through the perforations.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
