Well No. 7 is located 1650 ft. from [N] line and 1650 ft. from [E] line of sec. 14NE 1/4 (1/4 Sec. and Sec. No.) 208 (Twp.) 36E (Range) 104N (Meridian)Monmouth (Field) Leon (County or Subdivision) New Mexico (State or Territory)The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 3567 ft.

DETAILS OF WORK

Sanderson A-14, No. 7 is presently producing under a penalized allowable due to an excessive gas-oil ratio of 10,450 cubic feet per barrel.

In an attempt to reduce the present gas-oil ratio it is proposed to deepen the subject well from 3867' to approximately 3902, and a radioactivity survey run. A 4" OD liner will be set on bottom and cemented with approximately 50 sacks cement. The liner will be perforated opposite the favorable zones as indicated by the radioactivity survey, and the pay will be acidized through perforations.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
