FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

In order to regain production from the subject well, it is proposed to deepen the well to approximately 4240', install a 4" liner, and test all possible productive zones.

Subject well was completed 2-19-39 at a TD of 3840' in open hole section 3734-3840' for an I.P. of 1,008 BOPD, no water w/648 MCF gas. Shut-in during January 1955 due to no production. On 4-19-57 plugged back to 3802' and swabbed 100% water. Shut-in pending further study.

A subsequent report will be submitted upon completion of this work.
