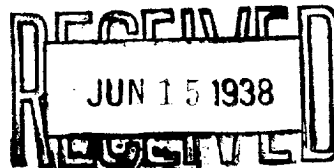
FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION
