Gentlemen:

Receipt is acknowledged of your "Notice of Intention to Drill"
dated October 8, 1937 covering well No. 2 on the subject land in NE $\frac{1}{4}$,
Sec. 35 T. 20S R. 36E You outline details of proposed work as follows:

Set casing as follows:

10-3/4", 40.5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", new, at 250' and cement with 100 sacks;
7-5/8", 26.40 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", new, at 1500' and cement with 400 sacks and
5-1/2", 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", new at 3850' and cement with 100 sacks.

Your proposed work is hereby approved subject to compliance with the
provisions of Section 2 of the "Oil and Gas Operating Regulations", revised
November 1, 1936, copy of which will be sent you on request.

The 5-1/2" casing must be cemented with 150 per cent of the amount
calculated to extend to the base of the salt.

Records and written notices relating to these well operations must be
submitted to this office in accordance with Section 5 of said operating
regulations. Any proposed change of detail of the work outlined above must
be submitted to this office on Form 9-331a, in triplicate, and approval
obtained before such work is commenced.
