COMPANY FOR AN ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER GRANTING
PERMISSION TO DUAL COMPLETE ITS STATE "H" NO.
1 IN THE EUMONT GAS POOL AND THE MONUMENT OIL
POOL.

Gentlemen:

With this letter, SKELLY OIL COMPANY is hereby petitioning the Secretary of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for administrative approval for an order granting permission to dual complete its State "H" No. 1 as a gas well in the Eumont Gas Pool and an oil well in the Monument Oil Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof does state:

1. That the petitioner is the owner and operator of an oil and gas lease confined by the W/2 NW/4 Section 25, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.
2. That the petitioner's State "H" No. 1 is located 1980' from the north line and 990' from the west line of the section and was completed in November 1937, as a Monument Pool oil well.
3. That the petitioner will dually complete its State "H" No. 1 in a manner described below.
 - a. Perforate the Queen within the interval 3480' to 3600' for Eumont Gas.
 - b. Run 2" tubing with a Baker Model "D" Retainer Production Packer to be set at around 3700' so as to segregate the two producing intervals.
 - c. Produce the Monument oil from open hole 3734' to 3852' through 2" tubing and the Eumont gas through the casing-tubing annulus.

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4. That the manner in which the petitioner has set out to complete the proposed dual is both mechanically feasible and practical and conforms to the Commission's policies and specifications as pertaining to the dual completion of dual gas and oil wells in the State of New Mexico.
5. That a diagrammatic sketch showing the producing intervals anticipated and the physical equipment to be used in dualling this well is hereto attached.
6. That a plat showing the above described lands and all offset properties, indicating well locations and lease ownership to the best of our knowledge, is hereto attached.
7. That the granting of this application for permission to dual this well is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.
8. That all offset operators are hereby notified by a copy of this application.

WHEREFORE, the petitioner requests that, in the interest of conservation and protection of correlative rights, the Secretary of the Commission grant an order pursuant to Rule 112-A, Order No. R-316 by which the petitioner may dually complete its State "T" No. 1 in the manner described above.

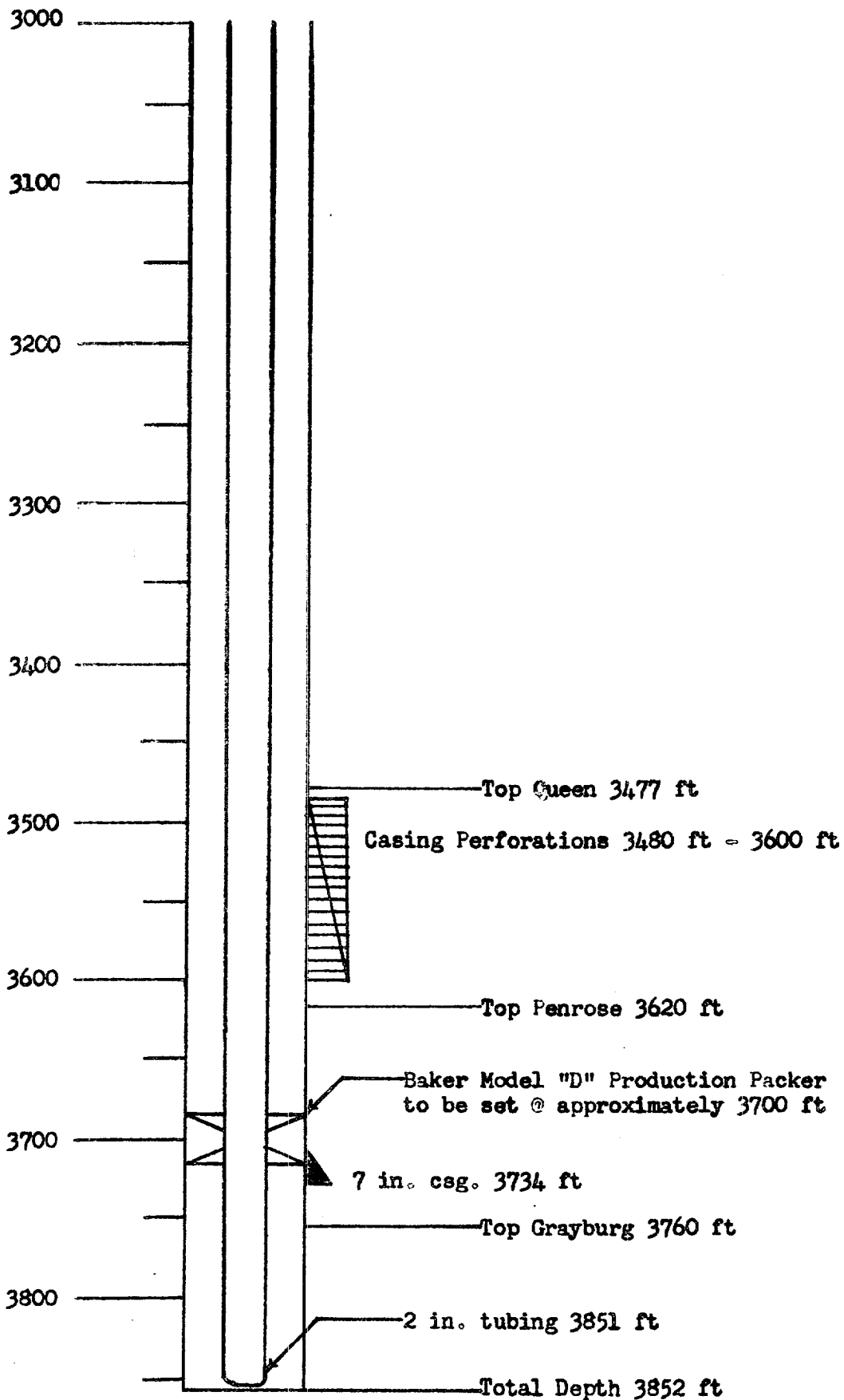

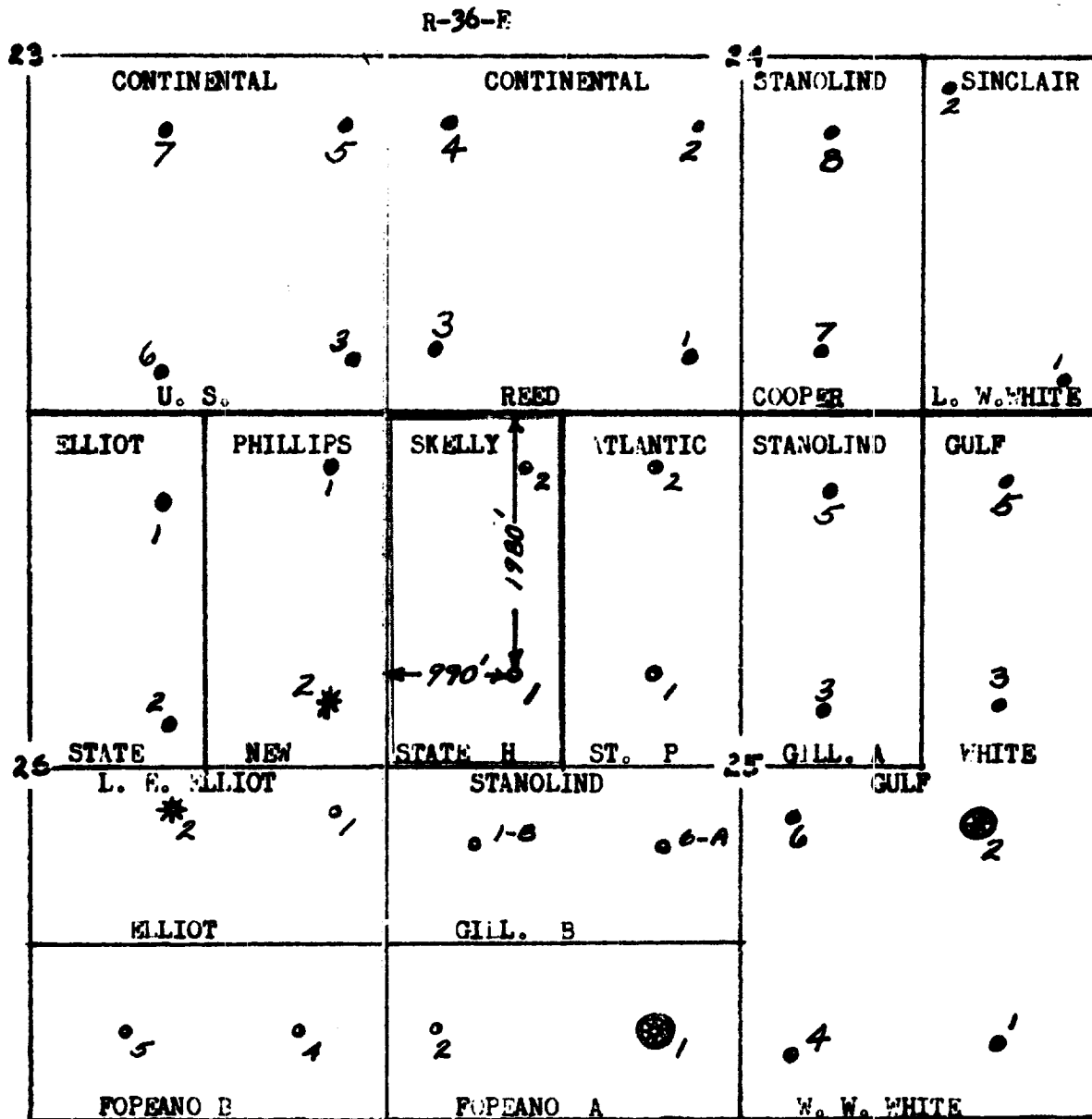
