DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 3850 **lime.** Introduced 1500 gal. acid thru tubing, treating pay formation from 3754' to T. D. with 1500 gal. Dowell XXF6. Flushed tubing with 14 bbls. oil. Swabbed 4 times to 2500' & well started flowing. Flowed oil load & acid 6 hours, no gauge and well was shut in to pressure up. On 4-hour test March 6th flowed 5.46 bbls. oil, no water. Tested thru 24/64" choke. Gas 311 MCF daily. Gas-oil ratio 9424. On 2-hr. test March 7th flowed 2.87 bbls. oil, no water thru 3/8" choke. Gas daily 271 MCF. Gas-oil ratio 7368.
