T. D. 3850 Line. Acidized with 1000 gallons Dowell "X" solution, thru tubing, treating formation from bottom of 7" casing (3696) to total depth **January 27, 1938.**

Before treating swabbed 18 hours recovering 148 bbls. drilling oil and 106 bbls. fresh oil, 0 water.

After treating swabbed 4 times and well started flowing. After recovering oil load & acid well flowed 233 bbls. fresh oil in 3 hours and was shut in for tank room.
