**T. D. 3810 Lime.** Loaded annular space with 67 bbls. oil and introduced 500 gal. Dowell XKF6. Flushed tubing with 10 bbls. oil. After swabbing well to life & flowing out oil load & acid well flowed 4 bbls. oil in 6 hours 5-31-40. 6-3-40 flowed 7 bbls. oil, no water in 6 hrs. 6-7-40 flowed 4 bbls. oil, no water in 6 hours. Gas daily 153 MCF. Gas-oil ratio 9583. After the test 6-7-40 this well was shut in pending decision as to procedure in future remedial work.
