DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 3810 Line. With packer set 3768' loaded annular space above packer with 98 bbls. oil & introduced 1000 gal. Dowell XXF6, treating formation from 3768' to total depth. Flushed tubing with 15 bbls. oil. Swabbed 6 times to 1800' & well started flowing. Flowed oil load & acid into pits. On 6 hour test thru 3/8" choke flowed ~~22~~ 5bbls. oil cutting from 2% to 4% acid water. Total ~~22~~ two hours 11 bbls. oil. Gas daily based on 2 hr. test 355 MCF. Gas-oil ratio 2686.
