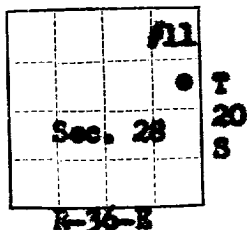

DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded 12 1/2" hole at 3:30 PM 2-18-57.

Finished 12 1/2" hole to 1774' at 6:45 PM 2-21-57. Ran 43 jts. 8-5/8" OD 24# Casing set at 1770' with 850 sacks, 50% Pennix & 50% regular cement mixed 2% Gal & 100 sacks Incon cement. Total of 950 sacks cement. Pumped plug to 1723' at 4 AM 2-22-57. Maximum pump pressure 600#, cement circulated. Did not rotate casing. Used 2 Baker centralisers. MOC. Tested 8-5/8" OD Casing with 1000#, held OK. Drilled cement inside 8-5/8" OD Casing from 1720' to 1770' & washed open hole from 1770' to 1774'. Started drilling 7-7/8" hole with gas from 1774' at 5 AM 2-23-57.
